1. President's Update – Matt Krauter

- a Matt felt that we should do some visioning for the playground area so we can fundraise more effectively. Another idea for spending: \$15,000 electronic sign (there is already electricity out at the sign); student council has \$4,000 earmarked for this sign, though it has not been a priority in the past. Staff has mentioned a big screen in the gym for assemblies and other events, though it wouldn't necessarily be used often. Staff will discuss it.

2. Principal's Update – Mrs. Wendy Tindall

- a MAP and PALS testing has been going on. Quarter 2 ends on Thursday. Conferences will be in late February. Parent-initiated transfer window is open. PBIS is heading toward tier 2, which is more focused and intensive.

3. Mrs. Jerry – Dream playground

- a The playground is up, and they thank the SSC and fundraising efforts.

4. What's up at Somers – staff updates

- a Mrs. Schantek - MAP testing for 5<sup>th</sup> grade, who is still finishing up. Black History bee is coming up for 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grades. Feb. 19<sup>th</sup> is the test, the 26<sup>th</sup> is the school competition, and March 1<sup>st</sup> is the district competition. Student Council is going to start a book drive and a penny drive soon.
